

New Cantonal Law Implementing Federal Regulations Regarding the Trimming of Hedges and Trees

Since January 1, 2025, the pruning of trees and trimming of hedges are only permitted from September 1 to March 15 of the following year, in order to protect wildlife, particularly birds.

It is essential to carry out this work in such a way that the distance from property boundaries is respected at all times, especially along public land (roads and sidewalks), in accordance with the rules defined in the 1987 Rural Code (see diagram below):



During the next trimming, it is important to anticipate branch growth so that the 0.5 m distance to public land is maintained at all times, both at ground level and at the top of the hedge.

For hedges, a trimming height of 2 meters must be observed along roads, sidewalks, and public paths!

<u>For the current year</u>, and considering the major change regarding the permitted trimming period, the Municipality will limit its actions to reminding property owners of these rules and <u>will authorize trimming that is necessary to clear public pathways, even outside the mentioned dates.</u>

Municipal Police Regulations Regarding Noisy Work

Since January 1, 2025, noisy leaf blowers (with an LWA¹ over 95 dB) may only be used from October to December.

Quieter leaf blowers, with an LWA of 95 dB or less, are permitted year-round.

The use of <u>very noisy devices</u> (with an LWA over 110 dB) <u>is subject to mandatory notification as very noisy work.</u>

We also remind you that noisy work of any kind is strictly prohibited:

- On Sundays and public holidays,
- On other days between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and between 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m.,
- On Saturdays from 5:00 p.m. onwards.

Property owners are requested to respect these rules and inform any companies they hire.

In the case of <u>exceptional events</u>, please inform your neighbours and notify the Municipality and SDS security company (022 776 40 41).

Walking Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a leash in public areas, including agricultural zones and forests. Please pick up after them and dispose of waste in the designated bins.

A dog park is available where they can roam freely, but always under their owner's supervision.

Even on a leash, dogs are not allowed on the beach or at the Sports Center, except on the terrace of the La Bohème restaurant (access only from the parking lot).
