## Municipal Police Regulations on Noisy Work

Noisy work of any kind, in particular lawn mowers, leaf blowers, high-pressure cleaners, or construction work, is only permitted:

**Monday to Friday from 07:00 to 12:00 and from 13:00 to 19:00**

**Saturday from 07:00 to 12:00 and from 13:00 to 17:00.**

Residents are requested to comply with these rules and to inform any companies they hire.

**Furthermore, noisy leaf blowers (LWA1 greater than 95 dB) may only be used from October to December.**

The use of other devices with an acoustic power emission value (LWA1) greater than 95 dB and up to 110 dB, which were acquired after 01.01.2025, is prohibited.

**The use of very noisy equipment, with an emission level (LWA1) greater than 110 dB, is subject to a requirement to declare very noisy work.**

## Private Parties

In the event of an exceptional private party, please notify your neighbours and inform the Commune, as well as the company SDS (022 776 40 41).

## Walking Dogs

Dogs must be always kept on a leash on public roads, including in agricultural areas and forests. Please pick up their droppings and dispose of them in the bins provided.

A dog park is available where dogs may move freely, but always under the control of their owners.

**Even when on a leash, dogs are not allowed on the beach or at the Sports Centre, except on the restaurant terrace (access via the parking lot only).**

Efforts continue in the Canton of Vaud to limit the nuisance caused by Asian tiger mosquitoes and prevent the transmission of disease.

As regards prevention, surveillance using nesting traps as well as larvicide treatments carried out in public areas of communes where the Asian tiger mosquito is established are continuing.

At present, the commune of Mies is not affected. If the Asian tiger mosquito is discovered in new communes, they will be informed.

The public is also invited to report the presence of the Asian tiger mosquito on the website [www.moustiques-suisse.ch](http://www.moustiques-suisse.ch).

If the mosquito is found in the commune, only the biological anti-larval treatment VectoBac must be used. It will be made available to residents by the commune as soon as it is available and only in confirmed cases. As a preventive measure, the public is encouraged to avoid standing water, for example by emptying plant saucers after rainfall.

## Pruning of Hedges and Trees

**We remind residents that since 1 January 2025, tree pruning and hedge trimming are permitted only from 1 September to 15 March of the following year, in order to protect wildlife, especially birds.**

In addition, it is essential to carry out this work in such a way that the distances to the property lines are respected at all times according to the rules defined in the Rural Code of 1987. Especially on the edge of the public domain (roads and sidewalks), **hedges must be trimmed respecting the height which must not exceed 2 meters and the lateral extension so as never to hinder the movement of pedestrians and vehicles.**
